

## Lesson 16: Big Bird, Big Egg

Materials: Ostrich Egg Photo

Miss Daniela's Class: fill a basket with toys and objects that are both larger and smaller than the Ostrich Egg Photo.

Invite children to take turns selecting a toy and comparing it to the egg photo.

Ask is the toy or egg larger?

Sort the items into two piles: bigger than the egg and smaller than the egg.

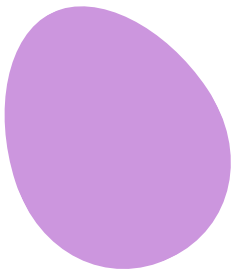
Miss Marissa's Class: Ask "How big do you think an ostrich is?"

Explain that ostriches can grow up to be nine feet tall. Line up blocks to measure nine feet. (2.7 meters)

Invite children to find eight items to measure.

Line them up from smallest to largest.

Encourage them to figure out how many items are larger than the ostrich egg.



The blocks are smaller than the egg!



The bear is bigger than the egg!
