15.3 DEVELOPS UNDERSTANDING OF OBJECT PERMANENCE

SUPPLIES

- Stacking cups
- Pompom, egg shaker or bottle cap

Hello, Egg

How does the child play with cups?

Young Infant

While the child is sitting, place a stacking cup on one of her hands.

READY?

How does she explore the cup? Does she shake it off? Does she touch it with her other hand? What emotions does she express?

Older Infant

While the child is crawling and playing, place stacking cups around the room with an egg shaker, pompom or bottle cap under one of them.

READY?

Encourage the child to crawl around and find each cup. Discover the hidden object. Explore passing the cup or found item back and forth.

Young Toddler

Place stacking cups around the room with an egg shaker, pompom or bottle cap under each. Invite the child to help you find and say hello to the "eggs."

READY?

As the child finds the cups and hidden objects, ask him to place the cups inside each other. Put them in order from biggest to smallest.
